

Drama Modifications

- Use the Step-by-Step Communicator or other voice output to greet classmates and the teacher.

- Play music or use the fan for wind, with the Powerlink and switch for warm up activities.



- Play sound effects with an switch with iPod and Hook or a switch operated tape recorder for classmates. Use the Timed function on the Powerlink.

- Deliver messages for the dance teacher
e.g.,
- Mrs. Johnson needs to borrow the extension cord. Do you have any that she can borrow?



- Provide questions regarding a theatre style being studied in dance class (e.g., improv, story theatre, etc.)

- Use a switch and Powerlink for special effects lighting for a play.
- Gather props or costumes for up-coming skits for the teacher.



- Provide instructions on the Step-by-Step Communicator for an improvisation that the class is working on.
- Use the voice output device or the All-Turn-It Spinner as demonstrated in these photos, to give different directions for warm up activities.
