

**Questions & Comments for Step-by-Step Communicator
(or other Voice Output Device)
for
Drama**

- Greeting and good-bye to drama teacher and classmates at the beginning and ending of class.
- Comments to a peer in a one-to-one practice:
 - Are you in the play coming up?
 - You act really well!
 - Am I getting better?
 - Can you help me rehearse my lines with you?
 - Who's your favourite actor?
 - What's your favourite kind of drama activity?
 - Have you ever watched Canadian Idol?
- Can I help get out any costumes or props?
- Can I help put any costumes or props away?
- Can I help run the music with my switch?
- Can I help play some sound effects with my switch?
- Can I help make the sound of wind with my switch and a fan?

Possible comments to program during a play practice:

- Feedback on the performance recorded on Step-by-Step.
- Applause recorded by the entire class on the Step-by-Step and played after a practice routine.
- Record the teacher's reminders about the next drama practice or tips on the Step-by-Step Communicator.
