Equipment and materials, which can be included in this activity:

- Single switch (as appropriate to your student)
- Step-by-Step Communicator
- Sample questions for Step-by-Step Communicator
- Picture communication board (where appropriate)
- Magazines or books, which have pictures pertaining to the themes being studied in the language arts topic (e.g., related to a story)
- Interview questions from the teacher that relate to some concept in the book or novel being read by the class.
- Recipes that relate to a theme being studied in socials (e.g., cookies cut into the shape of one of the characters or themes in the book)
- Objects that relate to aspects of the story or novel under study (object cues) to pose questions
- Questions from the teacher to have classmates answer in their reading
- Answers from the teacher to help check comprehension on reading questions
- Stencils created around the topic under study to help decorate theme related bulletin boards
- Powerlink and a switch to run electrical equipment (e.g., blender, shredder, electric stapler, etc.)
