

Additional Teaching Techniques

Instructional or Teaching Techniques To Encourage New Appropriate Responses

- Prompt Fading

Do not verbally prompt or nag, but use respectful physical prompts to decrease prompt dependency.

- Errorless Learning

It is important that the student not experience the inappropriate behaviour. We want to catch them before it occurs. Look for the preliminary behaviours.

- Instruct in Regular Settings

Do not remove the student for instruction, but use the actual functional settings in which the behaviours occur if possible.

- Provide Lots Of Repeated Experiences Or Practices

Massed trial will help your student learn the new communicative replacement for the undesired behaviour. Be prepared for a possible escalation of the behaviour, initially until your student learns that the new behaviour does really work.
